To expedite judging, jars should be filled to capacity with an air space of 6mm to be left at the top of the jar. Unless otherwise stated, all exhibits in this Section must be the property of and the produce of the exhibitor's own apiary or apiaries.

THE EXHIBITOR'S NAME MUST NOT APPEAR ON ANY EXHIBIT. Where multiple entries are made by any one exhibitor in any one class it is essential that individual exhibits be derived from a different FLORAL source.

Where in the opinion of a Judge, an entry is entered in the wrong class, the Judge may refer the matter to the Steward for inquiry, and upon the recommendation of the Judge, and at the discretion of the Steward, such entry may be transferred to the class for which it is eligible.
