3. All entries MUST be in place by 10am Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June. Late entries will not be accepted.
4. Cut Flowers are to be exhibited in green glass bottles. Stewards will have a limited number of bottles available for exhibitors if needed.
5. Dried floral arrangements to be exhibited ONLY where specified
6. Maximum pot size allowed is 30cm (diameter) or 13L
7. All potted plants to be the property of the exhibitor for at least 6 months prior to the show
8. Potted plant exhibits MUST be accompanied by a QCAS Biosecurity Pot Plant Form. These will be provided by the stewards.
9. Please follow all government directives regarding the movement of potted plants within [Fire Ant Zones](#)
