- 4. All cattle must be presented at the Lowood Showground Cattle Yards for weighing at 10.00am for judging on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup>
  June 2023
- 5. Entries close Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2023 No late entries accepted
- 6. NO AUCTION SALE WILL BE HELD. Cattle are to be consigned to the meat works, to be sold on weight and grade basis, according to owner's decision.
- 7. Class winners are required to stay in yards until 5.00pm Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2023
- 8. Current vendor declarations and other appropriate forms must be correctly completed and accompany cattle.
- 9. The Judges shall take into consideration breeding, quality, conformation, weight, evenness and depth of flesh and least waste. Criteria stand for all classes and the Judges reserve the right to withhold the awards unless in their opinion the exhibits are sufficient merit.
- 10. Exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor
- 11. All horned cattle to be tipped prior to their arrival at the Lowood Showgrounds
- 12. The Lowood Show Society will not accept liability for livestock exhibited. Such liability is strictly that of the exhibitor. It is the responsibility of the owner/person in charge of the stock, to ensure all cattle movement with regards to ticks have been met, by contacting their nearest Department of Primary Industries and Fisheries Office, to acquire a Travel permit with endorsed treatments if necessary. Persons not fulfilling requirements will be refused entry to showgrounds.
- 13. Tick infected cattle will not be allowed to compete and must be removed at order of the Chief Steward.
- 14. National Vendor Declaration Form/Waybill must be submitted with the Travel Permit at the showgrounds.
- 15. All QCAS affiliated agricultural societies have developed a comprehensive Agricultural Show Biosecurity Plan and all event organisers, competitors and spectators have a joint responsibility to ensure the successful implementation of a biosecurity plan.
